

Weekly Staff Update
April 8 to April 14, 2017

Significant Reports & Impacts

- No significant impacts to report.

Major Projects & Priorities

- *Wastewater Treatment Plant Upgrade.* Staff and the Design/Build team continue to create and combine punch lists for the project. The builder continues work on punch list items, site grading and prepping for paving. Public Works is preparing to move all of their materials and equipment off the WWTP site so grading can be completed in the upcoming weeks. The Resident Project Representative for the Town has been moved to part-time (20 hrs/week) as the project winds down.
- *Public Works Facility.* All trades continue interior finish installations such painting, fire alarm systems, HVAC, etc. The base coat of asphalt has been installed on the entire site. Exterior grade work continues, especially in the bio-retention pond area. Staff is working on a plan to begin moving crews, materials and equipment on-site once substantial completion is achieved.
- *Downtown Streetscape Enhancement.* Public Works continues water lateral replacements in the project area while 100% plans are being reviewed by VDOT.
- *Community Development Block Grant.* Town Council is asked to participate in the branding survey designed for stakeholders found at <https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/StrasburgStake>. If you have suggestions for other community stakeholders that should receive the survey, please send Michelle their contact information by April 21. Staff is still corresponding with Kee Construction on the demolition bid.
- *Northern Shenandoah Business Park.* Staff is working to identify possible funding sources for the construction of Borden Mowery Drive.
- *Strasburg Gateway Trail Project.* 100% Plans are currently being review by VDOT.
- *Downtown Revitalization and Tourism.* Staff is working with Shenandoah County Chamber of Commerce and the Parks and Recreation Department on offering a Movie in the Park this summer.
