DID YOU KNOW NEW WATER RATES

This month's utility bill will reflect the new rates that were adopted with the FY2019-20 Town of Strasburg Fiscal Budget. The minimum usage (2,000 gallons) of water, along with sewer, garbage, and recycling will result in a total bill of \$58.59. Out of town bill amount for minimum usage will now be \$66.63. Utility bills are due on the 20th of each month with past due payments needing to be paid by the 5th of the month.

Since all of us sometimes forget to pay a bill, the Town of Strasburg offers "Auto Draft" for your utility bill. Here is how it works:

- Sign up at the Town Office (174 E. King Street) or call (465-9197) or check our website (www.strasburgva.com) for a form.
- Your payment will automatically be deducted from your bank account on the due date.

Other payment options are also available. Credit cards are accepted at the counter for utility bills. In addition, utility bills and taxes can be paid online using Official Payments (a small fee will apply for online payments). On the town's website, click on the "Official Payments" link and follow the directions given. The Town's jurisdiction code is "9004". Please, always make sure you start an on-line payment from our website to ensure you are using the correct payment option for the Town.

SCHOOLS OPEN AUGUST 5

Shenandoah County Public Schools will open on **Monday, August 5th**. Drivers, please be on the lookout for children and be aware that students will be making their way to school by bus, car, foot, bike, scooter, or skateboard. Motorists need to be extra vigilant watching for children darting out from between parked vehicles and playing in and around sidewalks and crosswalks. Drivers also need to be aware of laws governing the sharing of roads and school parking lots with buses.

DMV CONNECT

Can't get to the DMV? Well, the DMV is coming to you...again! DMV Connect will be visiting the Town Hall on Tuesday, August 6^{th} , 10 a.m. – 3 p.m. The DMV Connect staff will be stationed in the Council Chambers and will be able to assist you with most of

DID YOU KNOW TAX TIDBIT

Did you know that if you have a delinquent balance on personal property taxes the Town participates with the DMV for collecting these bills? If your account has a DMV stop placed on it, there is an additional fee of \$45.00 and you will be unable to renew your vehicle registration until the balance is paid in full.


