Do You Know? Tax Tidbit

Did you know that recently the HB 489 legislation passed that will extend the DMV registration stop program to include vehicle purchases? Under this new law, a party with a DMV stop will not be able to get a full 1 year registration when a vehicle is purchased, but will instead receive an initial 90 day temporary registration to allow for the applicant to satisfy all requirements causing the DMV stop.

ALL positions are part-time beginning Memorial Day with required training and meetings prior to start date. Weekend and evening hours also required during season.

To be a lifeguard, you must be certified by the American Red Cross. The Town of Strasburg is offering a lifeguard training course in May. Information on the course, along with pricing, and times is listed below. Please note that completion of this course does not guarantee a job at the pool.



Summer 2019: Health and Safety Courses-

The Strasburg Community Pool will be hosting health and safety courses this summer to train applicants interested in becoming an American Red Cross certified lifeguard or reviewing for recertification. Course offerings and a tentative schedule for each of the course offerings is found below:

Upon successful completion of this course, participants will receive a certification from the American Red Cross via email valid for two-years.

Online Content for Lifeguarding Blended Learning Course: The Strasburg Community Pool is excited to offer you American Red Cross Lifeguarding Blended Learning. Blended learning combines online learning with in-person skills sessions where you will practice skills and demonstrate competency. Please plan to complete all eLearning modules, including the CPR/AED for Professional Rescuers and First Aid final eLearning exam, at least two days prior to your first in-person skills session. Most participants complete the eLearning portion of the course in approximately 7 hours. Your experience may vary widely based on several factors including your PC, internet speed and previous training. I recommend beginning the online session as soon as possible to ensure that you are able to complete all eLearning modules prior to the first in-person skill session.
