DID YOU KNOW TAX TIDBIT

Just a reminder that if you have not paid your first half of 2020 Personal Property or Real Estate tax bills, the extended penalty date is **September 3rd, 2020**. After this date, we will be adding the 10% penalty on the tax and the \$10 flat rate penalty on the license fees.

DMV CONNECT

Due to COVID-19, DMV Connect has not been able to visit Town Hall since February. The DMV has had to implement new ways to serve customers to ensure the safety of all, both customers and employees. As they are in the process of adjusting to the "new normal", it was determined to suspend the field operations of DMV Connect until further notice.

If you need the service of the DMV which cannot be done on-line, appointments can be made by visiting the DMV website: dmv.virginia.gov Please remember, employees of the Town of Strasburg are not affiliated with the DMV and do not know the answers for most questions regarding DMV transactions. Staff does not want to give out wrong information so please check the DMV website.

LARGE TRASH PICK-UP

The Town's contract with Waste Management does not include large item pick-up. Staff is in the process of planning a pick-up day for these items, but a date has not been finalized. Please do not place your large items on the curb now as they will not be picked up and we want to keep our town neat and clean. Watch future newsletters, the Town's website, and Facebook for the date of the large item pick-up. Also, remember that large items may be taken to the Shenandoah County Landfill, 349 Landfill Road, Edinburg, VA. Call (540-984-8573) or visit https://shenandoahcountyva.us/landfill/ for hours of operation and information on what items the landfill accepts. WM only accepts waste that is in the provided carts.
