



The Town of Strasburg is accepting applications for a customer service-oriented **Seasonal Pool and Recreation Manager**. Manager gets to oversee the scheduling of pool facilities, pool operations, supervision and scheduling of employees, ordering of supplies, and recreation program development. Manager will also work with the Community Development Coordinator, Shenandoah County Park and Recreation and others to implement activities and events such as the 4th of July Celebration, swim lessons, Doggie Dive-In, Senior Swim, Yoga in the Park and more. CPO, CPR, lifeguard, and first aid certifications are preferred within 60 days of hire.

TOWN ELECTIONS

Strasburg will be holding town elections for Mayor and four Council seats on Tuesday, May 5th, 2020. Any citizen interested in running for an open seat must complete and turn in all necessary paperwork and be certified by Lisa McDonald, Shenandoah County Voter Registrar, by Tuesday, March 3rd, 2020. It is recommended to have petitions turned in at least 10 days in advance of the March 3rd deadline to be sure all signatures are certified. Candidates must have at least 125 valid signatures. Also, be sure to have all required notarizations before returning packets to the Voter Registrar Office. To request a candidate packet, please call Ms. McDonald at (540) 459-6195.
