THANK-YOU TO DEPARTING COUNCIL MEMBERS AND MAYOR

On July 1st, the Town of Strasburg will have a new Mayor and four new Council Members. Leaving Council will be Mayor Rich Orndorff, and Council Members Kim Bishop, Barbara Plitt, Scott Terndrup, and Jocelyn Vena.

Rich Orndorff has dedicated a lifetime of service to this community. He has relationships in both State and Federal Government which he has used for the betterment of our community and citizens. His performance and duties as mayor have been characterized by his effective leadership of public meetings. Mayor Orndorff has currently served four years as mayor and prior to that, six years as a Council Member.

Kim Bishop joined Council in 2016, but prior to that, was a regular attendee at public meetings and spoke on various topics. Kim served as the chairperson of the Infrastructure Committee and met with staff often to learn about the Town's infrastructure so she could share information with the committee members and offer support to staff on projects.

Barbara Plitt also joined Council in 2016, and has served on varous committees. Her service on the Community Advisory Team was invaluable where her ideas and forward thinking were greatly appreciated. A special thanks goes out to Barbara for her beautiful butterflies she has painted and placed around town.

Scott Terndrup began his years of service as a Council Member in 2006 --- fourteen years of service! He has served on almost all town committees. His passion has been the town ordinances and he helped spearhead the writing of the Unified Development Ordinance. Scott served as the representative to the

Planning Commission for a total of nine years. He has also served as the Vice Mayor for the past four years. **Jocelyn Vena** has served the community for more than eight years as a member of the Strasburg Town Council. She, too, has served on most town committees through the years, but her service as the representative for the Town of Strasburg on the Northern Shenandoah Valley Regional Commission has been exemplary.


ATTENTION STRASBURG RESIDENT

The Town of Strasburg will be working with a **new solid waste collection company, Waste Management (WM),** beginning June 29, which will result in a few changes.

- The contractor will be collecting trash in one of four quadrants in Strasburg each Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday. Letters were sent to all households in Strasburg telling the resident their scheduled pick-up day. If you did not receive this letter, please call the Town Office ASAP (540-465-9197).
- 2. WM uses automated, side-load garbage trucks, which requires a standard cart type that can be picked up and dumped safely. Each customer should have already received one (1) 96-gallon cart at no additional charge. If you have not received a cart, please call the Town Office (540-465-9197). After the initial rollout of carts is complete, the Town and WM will accept requests from customers for 64-gallon carts, and/or the option to lease additional 96 or 64-gallon carts at a cost of \$1.00 each per month.
- 3. All trash and yard waste must be bagged inside of the contractor provided carts. Trash set out for pick up that is not inside of the contractor provided carts may not be picked up. See below for proper placement of carts. The Town is currently considering options for spring and fall "clean-up" days for bulk trash pick-up. Additional information on this will be in a future newsletter or found on the Town's website.
- **4.** Unfortunately, **WM** is unable to provide curbside recycling pickup. Residents who would like to continue to recycle may do so by taking sorted recyclables to the Shenandoah County Landfill or to 321 Powhatan Road in Strasburg, or another convenience site.

If you currently have a cart leased through American Disposal Services (ADS), they will be picked up on Saturday, July 11th. They have asked that customers place their leased containers out at the curb, completely empty, the night before or no later than 6 a.m. on July 11th.
