SANDY HOOK ELEMENTARY SCHOOL POP-UP LIBRARY

The Town of Strasburg has partnered with Sandy Hook Elementary School to provide "pop-up" library services to Strasburg families during this time of virtual schooling. Each Wednesday, beginning September 2^{nd} , the school will have staff at the Market Pavilion handing out books to families. The Pop-Up Library will be open from 1 - 3 p.m. and 6 - 8 p.m.

Speaking of books, the Strasburg Community Library will also have limited set hours each day to pick-up books on hold that are requested through the library's website, using your library card (http://ls2pac.countylib.org/#section=home,).

When picking up holds, you will need to show ID



and have a face-covering on. A volunteer with a face-covering on will come to the library door to get your ID and last name, check out the book(s) and give your holds to you at the door.

You can return any books at the same time you pick-up your new requests.

The Library is still NOT OPEN to browse, use computers, etc.
