STRASBURG MUSEUM NEWS

After being closed for the entire 2020 season, the Strasburg Museum is planning to open for the 2021 season in July and close at the end of October. The Museum will be open on Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays, 10 a.m. – 4 p.m. Regardless of being a lifelong resident of Strasburg, or a newcomer, you should plan a visit to the Museum to learn more about the Town's local history and heritage.

While waiting for the Strasburg Museum to open, stop by the Strasburg Visitor Center, located at 33229 Old Valley Pike. The Center is open daily, 9 a.m. – 5 p.m., and features walking trails, the Hupp's Hill Museum, and a gift shop. The Gift Shop is filled with many items made by local crafters.

A FEW REMINDERS:

Springtime is upon us and all are gearing up for warmer weather. Please, keep in mind a few reminders:

- Please clean-up after your dog when walking your pet along town streets or in the Town Park and Dog Park.
- Please wear reflective clothing when out walking, especially in neighborhoods with fewer streetlights, to ensure driver's see you.
- Please be considerate of your neighbors as you are out and about in the evenings and keep your voices and music turned down.
- Please remember it is the property owner's responsibility to mow and maintain their lawn and the height of the grass should not exceed eight (8) inches.
- If you are filling a swimming pool, please remember the town does not offer discounts on utility bills when filling pools. Your utility bill will reflect the amount of water used in filling the pool and sewer usage is based on the amount of water used so you will see an increase in your utility bill.

STOP Think before you flush. **DO NOT** flush any of these items:

- Rags and towels
- Clothing labels
- Toys
- Hair
- Syringes
- Underwear
- Cotton swabs
- Cigarette butts
- Rubber items (such as latex gloves)
- Candy and other food wrappers
- Plastic items of any description
- Disposable toilet brushes
- Baby wipes and diapers
- Sanitary napkins
- Cleaning sponges
