If you have an outstanding tax bill you will be receiving a "reminder" in the mail in the next few weeks. We will begin adding DMV stops to accounts in September 2021. Please be aware if your account has a prior year balance a DMV stop may already be in place. There is an additional fee of \$45.00 and you will be unable to renew your vehicle registration until the balance is paid in full.
