TAX TIDBIT

Your first-half of the 2021 Personal Property and Real Estate Tax are due on **June 7th**, **2021**. You may pay in person at the Town Office, or online at <u>www.strasburgva.com</u>, or mail to P.O. Box 351 Strasburg, VA 22657 (*must be postmarked by June* 7th and made payable to Town of Strasburg).

Just a reminder, Shenandoah County and the Town of Strasburg are non-prorating jurisdictions, so if you owned a vehicle on January 1, 2021, you will be billed for the entire year of 2021.



Failure to pay by the due date will result in a 10% penalty on the tax and a flat \$10.00 penalty on the license fee.

DMV CONNECT

Senator Mark Obenshain (R-Rockingham) and Del. Todd Gilbert (R- Mt. Jackson) are pleased to announce that they are partnering with the Virginia Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) to host a DMV Connect program on June 7th, 8th, and 9th at the Town Hall in Strasburg (174 East King Street Strasburg). Services will be by appointment only and priority will be given to residents of the 26th Senate District and 15th House District. Appointments will be available in fifteen-minute increments from 9am until Noon and 1pm until 4pm each day. Individuals can call Senator Obenshain's office at 540-437-1451 through June 4th to make their appointment.

DMV Connect can assist individuals with driver's licenses, REAL ID, i.d. cards, disabled parking placards, vehicle titling, address changes, vehicle registration and other essential services. Road testing and vital records requests cannot be accommodated at a DMV Connect program. More information can be found at the DMV Connect website.
