What materials should I <u>not</u> bring for shredding:

- Newspapers Phone Books
- Magazines Books Trash
- Any other public documents



Experts recommend you shred any confidential documents with:

- Account numbers (credit card statements, bank statements, canceled or unused checks, credit card receipts, utility bills, tax documents, etc.)
- Birth dates (school records, financial applications)
- Passwords and PINs (bank and credit card records)
- •Signatures (including canceled checks)
- •Social Security numbers (financial applications, tax documents, job applications)

*PLEASE REMOVE ALL METAL CLIPS, BINDERS AND
NOTEBOOKS OR OTHER METAL BEFORE BRINGING YOUR
MATERIALS.

A FEW REMINDERS

Springtime is upon us and all are gearing up for warmer weather. Please, take into account these few reminders:

- Clean-up after your dog when walking your pet along town streets or in the Town Park and Dog Park.
- Wear reflective clothing when out walking, especially in neighborhoods with fewer streetlights, to ensure driver's see you.
- Be considerate of your neighbors as you are out and about in the evenings and keep your voices and music turned down.
- Remember it is the property owner's responsibility to mow and maintain their lawn and the height of the grass should not exceed eight (8) inches.
- If you are filling a swimming pool, remember the Town does not offer discounts on utility bills when filling pools. Your utility bill will reflect the amount of water used in filling the pool and sewer usage is based on the amount of water used, so you will see an increase in your utility bill. This is also true when watering landscaping.

EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES WITH THE TOWN OF STRASBURG

Assistant Town Manager: The Town of Strasburg is seeking qualified applicants for the position of Assistant Town Manager (Community Initiatives). The person will perform a broad range of complex professional and administrative work by assisting the Town Manager and providing high level administrative direction to Planning and Zoning and Strategic Initiatives, as well as other departments, as assigned. Collaborates with the management team.

Planning Zoning **Administrator:** Planning/Zoning Administrator performs professional and technical work necessary to effectively support the Office of Community Initiatives under the supervision of the Assistant Town Manager. The position supports the administration of permitting activities and programs enabled Town's bv the zonina planning/development ordinances. A bachelor's degree in public planning or a related field and local government experience (1 to 2 years) is requested for this position.

Water Treatment Plant Operator/Trainee: The Town of Strasburg currently seeks a self-motivated individual with a Class 4 Waterworks license or higher and/or an individual that will accept the challenge of training to become an operator. This position requires a responsible, dedicated individual that has the ability to perform each essential function satisfactorily, displaying the knowledge, skill, and ability to perform all aspects of water treatment.

Public Works Technicians: The Town of Strasburg is seeking qualified individuals to perform intermediate skilled trades work assisting operations, construction and maintenance projects, repairing and maintaining machinery and equipment, maintaining records and files, and related work as apparent or assigned. Work is performed under the limited supervision of a Foreman.

Positions available on horticulture, streets, and utilities crews.

Police Officers: The Town of Strasburg is currently seeking applicants for the position of Police Officer. Officers are responsible for maintaining the safety and order of the community by enforcing all laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia and ordinances of the Town of Strasburg. Candidates should possess the ability to deal effectively with juveniles and adults, to analyze evidence, to question and interview skillfully, to organize and prepare clear and concise written reports and oral testimony, and to establish effective working relationships with the general public and coworkers.

Aquatic & Recreation Guards: These positions perform a variety of duties related to the oversight, care, and facilitation of Town of Strasburg aquatic and recreation activities to include, but not limited to, Strasburg Pool lifeguard and concession duties, recreation programming, and park maintenance. ALL employees will be required to have a current Red Cross Lifeguarding AND American Red Cross CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer certificate on file in the Strasburg Town Office.
