DID YOU KNOW ----- COMCAST CONTINUES WORK IN STRASBURG

Comcast has begun work in Strasburg that will result in the construction and operation of a Cable System. The Town granted Comcast a Franchise Agreement in November 2021. Property owners may notice markings on the ground (MISS Utility) prior to work to avoid any existing utilities within the right-of-way, followed by Comcast contractors installing the cable within the rightof-way through various methods (e.g. borings, excavations, etc.). Work is being confined to the rightof-way or easements as much as possible and this area and any other areas that are disturbed will be fixed/repaired once the work is complete. As a property owner, you may want to take a photo of the area prior to the work to document the existing conditions. Work is anticipated for the foreseeable future until all areas of the town are complete. TAX TIDBIT

If you have an outstanding tax bill you will be receiving a "reminder" in the mail in the next few weeks. We will begin adding DMV stops to accounts in September 2022. Please be aware if your account has a prior year balance, a DMV stop may already be in place. There is an additional fee of \$45.00 and you will be unable to renew your vehicle registration until the balance is paid in full.

2022 Second half taxes will be due on Dec. 5.

RATE INCREASES

Last month, the newsletter noted changes to fees and rates that came with the adoption of the FY2023 Budget. Please note, you will see the increase in your sewer rate on your bill for this month. In-town rates increased by 4% and out-of-town rates increased by 6%. Also, trash collection fees will now be \$13.38 per month; additional carts are \$1.05 per month. Water System News!

Fort Hill Water Tank Paint Project

The Fort Hill water tank, located at 326 Banks Fort Road and built in 1930, is due for new paint. Because the old paint needs to be removed and it contains lead, the tank will be completely enclosed, and an air filtration system will be used to safeguard area residents. Once the new paint is applied (same color as it currently is painted), the cell antennas will be remounted, and the tank placed back in service. The project should be complete around October of this year.

Advanced Metering Infrastructure Project

The Strasburg Town Council recently approved a contract with Core & Main, LP, out of Martinsburg, WV, to convert our water meter system from a combination of walking routes and drive-by routes to an Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) system. AMI systems use radio repeaters throughout Town that can communicate with new meters directly and upload data quickly and accurately to Town Staff. The new AMI system will include an online customer portal that residents can use to help trouble shoot water leaks, monitor daily usage, and even notify water users by text message or email if a leak is detected or if more water is used than expected. The AMI system is expected to be completed near the end of this year.
