THE TOWN OF STRASBURG HIRES NEW ASSISTANT TOWN MANAGER

The Town of Strasburg is pleased to announce that Ms. Mellanie Shipe has been selected to fill the position of Assistant Town Manager, effective August 28, 2023.

Ms. Shipe has more than 21 years of local government experience, the last four in a



leadership role as the Shenandoah County Emergency Communications Director. During her tenure with Shenandoah County, she worked on several projects, including the construction and relocation of the new 911 center, the upgraded public safety radio system, and the County's implementation of the Next Generation 911 platform. Shipe is a graduate of Strasburg High School, California Coast University (B.S. in **Business** Administration) and holds a Master of Public Administration from Liberty University. In addition, she has a Certificate of Leadership Development from Laurel Ridge Community College, as well as various other leadership, project management and emergency management certifications.

The role of Assistant Town Manager is an important role in that it provides a key leadership position to bring together the values and visions of the Town and the Town programs and initiatives throughout Departments. As the Assistant Town Manager, Ms. Shipe will partner with the Town Manager and other department directors to develop strategies that create change to better serve the residents, businesses, and visitors of the Town of Strasburg.

TOWN DECLARES DROUGHT WATCH CONDITION; ENCOURAGES VOLUNTARY WATER CONSERVATION MEASURES

<u>HIGHLIGHTS OF THE ADOPTED FY2023-24 BUDGET</u> (Changes from FY2022-23 Budget to FY2023-24 Budget)

Tax Rates/Fees:

 Real Estate Taxes: \$0.155 per \$100 assessed value (based on 100% assessment); effective January 1, 2024; (increase from \$0.145).

Trash Collection Fees:

 \$16.60 per month (increase of \$3.22); \$1.11 for additional carts (increase of \$0.08). Rate increases are reflected in the August utility bill.

DID YOU KNOW....AUGUST TAX TIDBIT

Just a reminder....if you have not paid your personal property taxes by August 31, 2023, a DMV stop will be added to your account beginning September 5, 2023. Please be aware, if your account has a prior year balance, a DMV stop may already be in place. There is an additional fee of \$45.00 and you will be unable to renew your vehicle registration until the balance is paid in full.


