DO YOU KNOW? TAX TIDBIT

Did you know that any outstanding balance due on Real Estate or Personal Property taxes has been turned into the Virginia Dept. of Taxation for collection. The Debt Set Off Program matches any outstanding bills the taxpayer may have with any available refunds. To prevent any delay in receiving your state refund please be sure your taxes are paid.

2023 First half taxes will be due on June 5th.

PUBLIC HEARINGS SCHEDULED

Public hearings for an amendment to the zoning ordinance will take place with the Planning Commission on Tuesday, February 28th at 7 p.m. and the Town Council on Monday, March 6th at 7 p.m. The subject of the public

PROPOSED FY2024 BUDGET

Town staff has started work on the FY2024 Budget. Department heads have submitted their preliminary budgets to Town Manager Coggsdale and meetings are scheduled with these individuals. All meetings will be held in the Council Chambers of the Strasburg Town Hall, 174 E. King Street, Strasburg, and are open to the public.

115 WEST KING STREET

The Town of Strasburg officially closed on the purchase of 115. W. King Street on Monday, December 19, 2022. The Town Council approved authorizing the town manager to proceed with the purchase at their

December 6, 2022, Work Session; the vote was unanimous. The site is the former BB&T Bank, which later became Truist.

The building, built in 1955, is located at the corner of West King Street and South Holliday Street and contains 6,440 sq. ft. and sits on a 0.546-acre lot. The purchase of the building is the first step in providing adequate space for the delivery of town services to its citizens. Town Council has indicated for the past several years that additional space was needed and with the closure of the bank, the downtown location became a priority. Staff is currently in the process of issuing a Request for Proposals for an architectural/engineering firm to begin work on the design for renovations.

The building is expected to be completed and ready for Town use in 2024.

BUSINESS LICENSE INFORMATION

Business Licenses need to be renewed annually by March 1. Additionally, if you have any signs (building mounted, window signage, free-standing, sandwich boards, etc.), plan to expand, or wish to start a home business, you will need a permit. Regulations are outlined in the Town of Strasburg's Unified Development Ordinance. Email Brian Otis, the Town's Planning and Zoning Administrator, (botis@strasburgva.com) if you have any questions or to find out if you are in compliance with your zoning.

Also, if you are planning to open a restaurant or other food establishment, be sure to contact Tax Clerk Emily Ritenour to find out all the ins and outs of meals tax --how much must be collected, when the tax is due to the Town, what can happen if the tax is not turned into the Town, etc. Visit Emily at the Town Hall, email her at eritenour@strasburgva.com, or call 540.465.9197.
