DID YOU KNOW.....

The date to pay your first half personal property and real estate taxes to the Town of Strasburg without penalty has been extended to June 26, 2023.

Ways to pay:

Failure to pay by the due date will result in a 10% penalty on the tax and a flat \$10.00 penalty on the license fee. If you have questions, please call the Town Office at 540-465-9197.

As an FYI, this extension applies to Town of Strasburg taxes only; Shenandoah County taxes are due on June 5.

THE UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE IS GOING THROUGH A REWRITE!

Planning & Zoning Administrator Otis is currently in the process of rewriting the Unified Development Ordinance (UDO) and making it more user friendly. The Town has contracted with the Berkley Group to facilitate workshops which will be open to the public, where interested parties can address any concerns related to the existing zoning ordinance and say what they would like to see moving forward.

Meetings will be held on Monday, June 12, and Thursday, July 13. Both meetings will be held at Strasburg High School Cafeteria and will be from 5 p.m. – 6:30 p.m.
