#### DID YOU KNOW......

Springtime is upon us, and all are gearing up for warmer weather. Recent February days have flowers blooming and grass ready to grow. Please, take into account these few reminders as we head into Spring:

- Remember it is the property owner's responsibility to mow and maintain their lawn and the height of the grass should not exceed eight (8) inches.
- Clean-up after your dog when walking your pet along town streets or in town parks and the dog park. Also, please clean-up after your pet if it decides to use your neighbor's yard as its bathroom.
- Wear reflective clothing when out walking, especially in neighborhoods with fewer streetlights, to ensure drivers see you.
- Be considerate of your neighbors as you are out and about in the evenings and keep your voices and music turned down.
- The Market Pavilion and Strasburg Square are great places to meet friends. Please, dispose of litter properly and respect the public bathrooms.

#### DO YOU KNOW? TAX TIDBIT

If you owned your vehicle on January 1, 2023, this is the vehicle you will pay tax on for the entire tax year of 2023. If you are a new resident and were not here on January 1, 2023, you will need to pay your prior jurisdiction for the entire year of 2023.



2023 First half taxes will be due on June 5th.










Daylight Saving Time starts at 2 a.m. on Sunday, March 12. Be sure to SPRING FORWARD (turn your clocks forward one hour).


