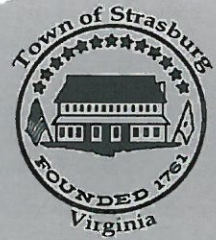

## ATTENTION DOG AND CAT OWNERS

Do you own a dog? Do you take your dog for walks? Please, be considerate of other walkers and property owners by cleaning-up after your dog. "Gifts" left along the sidewalks or on another person's property are not wanted!



Not only are they not wanted, but it is unlawful to allow a dog to defecate on public or private property except under the provisions of Section 18-33 of the Town Code which reads: "It shall not be unlawful to allow defecation

by such animal within the described public or private property if the owner of the animal removes the animal's excrement immediately and disposes of it in a public trash receptacle or in a public sanitary sewer, or on the owner's own property in a lawful manner." People who do not own pets, should not have these "gifts" left in their yards to clean and walking for all, either along town streets, the River Walk, or Town Park, should be enjoyable. Dog owners, please follow these rules. Also, even though there are not ordinances specific to cats, please have the same consideration for others if you own a cat and keep your cat confined to your own yard.

## ARE YOU MOVING?

Are you planning to move out-of-town? To make sure you are billed correctly for personal property and real estate taxes, please contact the Shenandoah County Commissioner of Revenue office at 540-459-6170. Just changing your address through DMV does not guarantee that the county and town will be notified of the move and you could continue to receive tax bills.

Not paying a personal property tax bill can lead to a DMV stop so, please help make your life less stressful by calling the Commissioner of Revenue when you move.

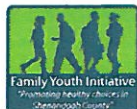


# TUESDAY, AUGUST 4, 2015 NATIONAL NIGHT OUT
