## **NEW FACE IN TOWN**

On July 6<sup>th</sup>, we will welcome Ryan Spitzer as the new Town Manager for the Town of Strasburg. Mr.



Spitzer was chosen from a field of 35 candidates to fill the vacancy created when Judson Rex left in January to accept the position of Assistant Town Manager for the City of Denison, Texas. Since January, Jay McKinley has been serving as Acting

Town Manager. Jay will continue on as Assistant Town Manager which will help to make the transition easier.

Mr. Spitzer did his undergraduate work at Virginia Tech, majoring in Environmental Policy and Planning and received his Master's degree from Tech in Applied Economics and an M.B.A. from Radford University. He also has graduate certificates in Foundations of Political Analysis and also Local Government Management from VA Tech. He has served as the manager for the Town of Glasgow and most recently as the assistant manager for the Town of Vinton. He is a native Virginian, having grown up in the City of Staunton. He feels the size of Strasburg is perfect for him since he doesn't see himself in a large city.

## **CELEBRATING VIRGINIA'S LOCALITIES**

The Executive Mansion recently announced that the theme for its 2015 Holiday Tree will be "Celebrating Virginia's Localities." They are asking localities to submit one hand-crafted ornament that uniquely represents their community. The holiday tree will be on view to the public throughout the holiday season and will be seen by thousands of visitors to the Executive Mansion in Richmond.

The Town of Strasburg has decided to ask our citizens for help in the creation of our Town's ornament. We will be accepting ornaments until October 1, with the winning ornament being sent to

the Executive Mansion. All other submissions will be displayed at the Strasburg Town Hall. Please, put your creative talents to work and make an ornament. Below are a few guidelines to follow:

- The theme of the ornament is totally up to the person submitting; however, it is suggested to depict some unique feature of our community such as an historic home, a person, or event, or a natural feature (mountain, river, etc.). Think of things that make Strasburg special.
- The size of the ornament should be no larger than 6". Shape and material is totally up to the artist/artisan. The finished ornament should have the name of the artist and "Town of Strasburg" on the back.
- The artist/artisan should reside in or near the Town of Strasburg. As the mansion may feature a children-themed tree in the future, it is being asked that this year's ornaments be created by adults.
- All ornaments must be handmade; no purchased ornaments.
