DID YOU <u>KNOW.....</u>

The Town of Strasburg operates and maintains a water treatment facility and a wastewater treatment facility, along with several pumping stations and miles of underground lines to transport the clean water to the homes and the used water to the wastewater treatment facility.

To fund these services, the Town charges users a monthly water and sewer fee. This fee is based on the actual cost to operate our facilities and maintain the distribution (water) system and collection (sewer) system. A separate water fund and sewer fund have been created to accept the fees (revenue in) and pay for the goods or services needed (expenditures out). The goal is for the funds to remain revenue neutral, be self-supporting (no tax dollars used) and to provide state and federal levels of service to our customers.

At times, the Town has found it necessary to upgrade our water and wastewater facilities. In the case of the water facility, an upgrade was needed to keep up with the demand in the distribution system. The wastewater plant is currently being upgraded to provide a higher level of treatment to satisfy the requirements of the Chesapeake Bav Act.

In both cases, the Town had to borrow the funds to perform the upgrades. The loans are broken down into yearly debt amounts that are paid from the water and sewer fund balances. If either fund balance goes negative, then rates must be adjusted to make the funds revenue neutral again.

Notifying this office of any changes to vehicles you own will help ensure your personal property taxes are correct. Please be aware that you will be billed the entire year for any vehicle

owned on January 1st of the tax year; the Town, as well as Shenandoah County, does not pro-rate taxes. The Town of Strasburg receives all tax information from Shenandoah County so Town Staff cannot change tax records without prior notice from Even if you have changed your the county. information with DMV, it is a good idea to notify the Commissioner's office.
