DID YOU KNOW....



The Strasburg Dog Park will be opening on Saturday, July 8th. A Grand Opening Celebration and Ribbon Cutting will take place at 10 a.m. To make sure the park is enjoyable

for all, please note the following rules:

- The park is for dogs and their handlers only.
- Handlers must be at least 16 years of age.
- Children 8 and under are not allowed in the off-leash area. Children 9 -15 must be accompanied by an adult.
- No food, drinks in glass containers or smoking. Dog training treats are allowed.
- Dogs must be licensed, vaccinated, healthy, and collared/harnessed. Handlers must have owner identification. No spike collars or choke chains.
- All dogs must have a handler.
- ❖ Please clean up and dispose of waste IMMEDIATELY.
- ❖ Maximum of two (2) dogs per owner/handler is allowed.
- Dogs must be at least 4 months old, and no female dogs in heat are allowed in the dog park.
- Handlers are responsible and liable for the actions and behavior of their dogs at all times. Keep a leash in hand and your dog in view. No digging, but if holes are dug, please cover them immediately.
- Users of the dog park do so at their own risk and agree to fully release and hold harmless the Town of Strasburg and its employees and agents from any and all claims of injury at the park.
- Remove dogs from the park at the first sign of aggression. NO EXCEPTIONS. Dogs with a history of aggressive behavior are not permitted.
- Dogs under 30 pounds must use the small dog area. Dogs 30 pounds or more must use the large dog area. Elderly dogs may use the small dog area.
- Violators will be subject to removal from the park and park privileges suspended.

FY2017-18 BUDGET APPROVED

The Town Council passed the FY2017-18 Budget on June 13th. As an FYI, Real Estate and Personal Property taxes will remain the same for the next year. Utility rates will increase. Below, are the new residential rates. Water:

- Residential \$25.07 minimum per 2,000 gallons
- \$12.17 per 1,000 gallons over minimum
- Outside of town, same as above plus 40%

Sewer:

Residential \$20.58 minimum per 2,000 gallons

- \$11.17 per 1,000 gallons over minimum
- Outside of town, same as above plus 40%

Trash \$8.95 per household/apt. per month Recycling \$2.05 per household/apt. per month

Overall, a minimum in-town bill for water, sewer, trash and recycling will be \$56.65; this is an increase of \$1.47 over last year.
