Kimberly Henley Miller is the featured artist for October and November. Mrs. Miller is the wife of Strasburg's Town Attorney, Nathan Miller.

Kimberly has a BA in Business and Communications from Baldwin College and a BFA from James Madison University. She is a member of the National Society of Collegiate Scholars



and has taught Art at Blue Ridge Community College. She has also served on the Arts Council of the Valley and The Visual and Performing Arts Council of JMU. Kimberly has participated in vocal/theatre performances and studied classical ballet.

Kimberly has had numerous solo exhibitions and her art is in both public and private collections. Places she has had her artwork exhibited include: Sentara Hahn Cancer Center, the Virginia State Capitol (twice), J. Sargeant Revnolds Community College, James Madison University, Mary Baldwin College, Bridgewater College, and many other locations throughout the Commonwealth. Featured in the Town Hall, her exhibition is entitled "Different Strokes for Different Folks" and showcases the artist's wide range of techniques (brush squeegee, palette knife, and plant material) and various medium.
