DID YOU KNOW...SANTA HAS A SPECIAL MAILBOX AT TOWN HALL!

DO YOU KNOW? TAX TIDBIT

Tax bills are due on December 5, 2018. You can pay online at strasburgva.com, by mail (PO Box 351), night drop box or in person at the Town Office (174 E. King Street). Any bill that is not paid by December 5, 2018 is subject to a 10% penalty.

SNOW WILL FALL AGAIN!

We have already had our first snow of the year and more will probably be falling soon. Residents are required by Town ordinance to clear sidewalks after every storm. Snow or ice should be removed during the first six hours of daylight following the time when snow or ice ceases to fall or form. When residents fail to clear snow and ice, school children, elderly, handicapped, and other pedestrians, are force to walk on snow or ice-packed sidewalks, or in the street, which can lead to serious injury. Please pile snow in your own yard, and NOT in the street, where it will block the flow of storm water. By keeping gutters and/or ditches clear of snow, most ice problems can be avoided.

To help the Town Crew as they are plowing streets, please park vehicles in driveways or off of the street so the entire street can be plowed. Also, give a wave and a thank you to these guys as they work hard to make our streets safe.

TRASH & RECYCLING NEWS

Due to American Disposal Services, our trash and recycling company, being closed on Christmas Day to allow workers time to enjoy the holiday with their families, trash and recycling will be picked up on <u>THURSDAY</u>, <u>DECEMBER 27</u>.
