The *DMV2Go* mobile office is a full service office and performs <u>every vehicle and</u> *driver transaction* that can

be done at customer service centers! A few examples of transactions include:

TOWN ELECTIONS

Strasburg will be holding town elections for four Council seats on Tuesday, May 1st, 2018. Any citizen interested in running for an open seat must complete and turn in all necessary paperwork and be certified by Lisa McDonald, Shenandoah County Voter Registrar, by Tuesday, March 6th, 2018. It is recommended to have petitions turned in at least 10 days in advance of the March 6th deadline to be sure all signatures are certified. Candidates must have at least 125 certified signatures. Also, be sure to have all required notarizations before returning packets to the Voter Registrar Office. To request a candidate packet, please call Ms. McDonald at (540) 459-6195. 

JUST A REMINDER.....

If you have recently sold or traded a vehicle or if you have moved either out of or into the Town of Strasburg, please contact the Shenandoah County Commissioner of Revenue's office at 540-459-6170. Notifying this office of any changes to vehicles you own will help ensure your personal property taxes are correct. Please be aware that you will be billed the entire year for any vehicle owned on January 1st of the tax year; the Town, as well as Shenandoah County, does not pro-rate taxes. The Town of Strasburg receives all tax information from Shenandoah County so Town Staff cannot change tax records without prior notice from the county. Even if you have changed your information with DMV, it is a good idea to notify the Commissioner's office.

Also, if you have recently changed your phone number, please let the Town Office know. This helps Town Staff keep records up-to-date.
