SNOW WILL FALL SOON!

Snow will probably be falling before long. The Town Code requires all residents with properties abutting curbed or paved sidewalks to remove the ice and snow from the sidewalk. Snow or ice should be removed during the first six hours of daylight following the time when snow or ice ceases to fall or form. Town taxes were due on December 5th and if you happened to overlook paying these, please be aware that beginning January 2, 2018, unpaid balances on accounts will be turned into the Virginia Department of Taxation for collection.

WHAT CAN'T BE FLUSHED?

Toilets and garbage disposals often are used as trash cans. Certain materials can cause damage to the Town's sanitary sewer system or cannot be broken down through the sewage treatment process. The following items should not be placed into any interior drain (toilet, garbage disposal, sink, tub, etc.):

- Grease: Grease coagulates after being poured down a drain. Grease should be placed in a spill proof container and either recycled or disposed of properly according to the manufacturers recommendations.
- Hand Towels and Shop Towels: Only toilet paper is designed to be disposed of in toilets. All other towels need to be disposed in the trash.
- 3. <u>Hair</u>: Sink traps should be cleaned on a regular basis and trapped hair should be disposed of in the garbage.
- 4. <u>Baby Wipes and Other Hygiene Products</u>: These items should be placed in the trash can and not in the toilet.
