#### **TALL GRASS**

May was very rainy and grass is growing. Please, keep in mind -----

- It is the property owner's responsibility to mow and maintain their lawn and the height of grass should not exceed eight (8) inches.
- Properties whose grass exceeds eight (8) inches will receive only ONE NOTICE of violation for the entire year before the Town cuts your grass and sends you a bill.
- Lawn maintenance is very beneficial! Mowing height and of frequency will determine how healthy and attractive your lawn looks.
- Violations can be reported through your mobile device with a free mobile app, Your GOV.


